

# HRSA Behavioral Health Workforce Education Training Paraprofessional Funding Application Academic Year 2020-2021

Through federal funding provided by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), the Departments of Social Work and Human Services and Counseling at MSU Denver are able to offer a limited number of financial awards to undergraduate and certificate-seeking students, who are committed to working with substance use/dependency, and/or high-risk youth in rural and medically undeserved Colorado communities. The HRSA BHWET Paraprofessional Program is designed to invest in education and community to develop and expand the Colorado substance abuse and mental health workforce.

For the 2020-2021 academic year, any student, who believes that their academic path meets the criteria listed below, is welcome to apply. *Please carefully review the details below for complete application requirements and student obligations.* 

#### I. WHO MAY APPLY FOR THE 2020-2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

Students or individuals who meet requirements from <u>A and B</u> are eligible to apply for the HRSA BHWET Paraprofessional Funding Program for the 2020-2021 academic year:

- **A.** Current MSU Denver undergraduate or non-degree students who are seeking a **certificate** in **Addiction Studies** (**CAC I or II**) or **High Risk Youth** from the Department of Human Services and Counseling.
- **B.** Undergraduate Students who have **completed a minimum of 60 credit hours** (junior or senior) and are currently in good academic standing.

OR

**B.** Non-degree seeking students who will complete all required certificate coursework within 12-months of receiving the funding.

#### II. STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

Students who are selected and choose to accept the HRSA Funding must:

- Successfully complete all required undergraduate or certificate coursework and program requirements.
- Commit to working in Colorado within the corresponding field of focus (Addictions or High Risk Youth) for a period of time equivalent to 6 months post-graduation/completion.
  - Employment must be secured within 12 months of graduation/completion and verified with MSU Denver HRSA staff once obtained.
  - Regular contact with MSU Staff is expected until the 6-month employment requirement is completed and the terms of the funding contract have been fully met.

Failure to complete the 6-month post-grad employment, or any other obligation mentioned in the contract will require the student to return, or payback all award funds received.

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#### III. FINANCIAL SUPPORT

**Financial support up to \$3.000** is available to each recipient. Funds may be dispersed over 12 months for full-time students, and over 24 months for part-time students. All HRSA Paraprofessional funds will be initially released to the Office of Financial Aid, then applied to the MSU accounts of individual recipients.

In all cases, financial awards will be granted to selected applicants on a first come, first serve basis, and will only be available as long as grant funds are available. An award may be canceled in its entirety, or funds may be partially distributed with subsequent payments being canceled if grant funds are withdrawn, or if contract obligations are violated. Completion of the application and/or submission of letters of recommendation do not guarantee funds being awarded.

#### IV. APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Application packets must include all of the following:

- **Application Form:** Included at the end of this document.
- Resume: 1-2pgs and <u>UPDATED</u> (including educational and work/volunteer experience)
- Cover Letter: 250 words approx., explaining the reason for your interest in the HRSA program, with a focus
  on your specific interest in your chosen degree/program and/or field of work (Addiction Studies or High Risk
  Youth).

Applications will be reviewed and accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Only completed application packets will be reviewed for acceptance. Awardees will be selected based on the quality of the entire application packet. Applicants will be notified by email of their acceptance status.
