## Step 3: Search courses by the subject (Prefix) or enter a keyword

Study courses are published in the Class Schedule.

**Topics or omnibus courses** are temporary courses that are not listed in the Catalog. They may be used to present a special topic, or provide a unique, experiential-learning opportunity. Omnibus courses use a wide range of course numbers: 190\_, 290\_, 390\_, 490\_ and include an alpha character in the course number. These courses are published in the Class Schedule.

**Topic courses** allow courses of varying titles under an overall theme or "umbrella" course. Variable topic courses include an alpha character in the course number and are published in the Class Schedule.
