ELECTIVES

Students pursuing this option do not need a minor. For the language emphasized, French, German or Spanish, students must complete a minimum of 42 hours of course work at the 2000 level (no more than 12 hours) and above.

See Option I. To complete the 60 hour requirement, students must take a minimum of 18 hours at the 2000 level or above in a second language. These second language courses consist of the following:
