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Steps to Register for PSY 2320 (Inferential Statistics) or PSY 2330 (Statistics and Research Methods for the Social and Behavioral Sciences I)

1. **FOR 2320:** You must be enrolled in PSY 2310 (Introductory Statistics for Soc), or have taken the equivalent of Intro to Statistics.
FOR 2330: You must complete the Major's Quiz online assessment, and meet with an advisor prior to registration.
2. You must go to the Department of Psychology website:
<http://www.mscd.edu/psychology/>.
3. On the left navigation bar, you will click on 'Psychology Major/Minor.'
4. In the left column click on the 'Major's Quiz' link. <http://www.mscd.edu/psychology/psychologymajorminor/majorsquiz>.
5. On the next page, click on the 'online training' link to begin.
6. The training will take approximately 15-20 minutes. Once completed, you will receive an email confirmation in your MSCD email account.
7. Print the confirmation email and take it to the Psychology Department, room 220 to see an advisor.
8. Please check the online advising schedule (www.mscd.edu/psychology/psychologymajorminor/advising.) for available advising hours and call 303-556-3205 to make an advising appointment.
9. The advisor will review the requirements for the course and will complete documentation (purple sheet) which will be returned to the front office staff.
10. **For 2320**, the hold will then be released by the front office staff and the student will be able to register themselves.
For 2330, the student will need to provide the CRN of the course they wish to attend, and the front office staff will register the student in the class.
