ELECTIVES IN THE MAJOR: 3 credit hours from ART, ARTH, or CDES

A grade of "C" or better is required in each required course, including the specific General Studies requirements, Art Foundation, Art Education Concentration, and Studio Emphases, before progressing to subsequent courses. Students should be aware that the B.F.A. is the only degree available for Art Education. Students pursuing the B.F.A. degree must pass the portfolio review in order to be admitted into the degree program. Additionally, students must have completed the Written Communication, Oral Communication, and Quantitative Literacy General Studies requirements and have a minimum of 3.0 G.P.A. at the time of portfolio review. Coursework preparing for teacher licensure is available for post-baccalaureate students who have a prior B.F.A. degree. Post-baccalaureate students with a B.A. in Art should be prepared to take additional art and art history coursework, or to enter the B.F.A. program.
