Students who are declared HCM majors and have an associate’s degree in a health occupation may substitute up to 24-credit hours of selected, approved associate degree major courses in place of a minor. Students who have attended the Paramedic School at the Denver Health Medical Center, obtained a Paramedic Certificate and received state licensure as a paramedic may use this in lieu of the minor.
