

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)

What is WUE?

WUE is the Western Undergraduate Exchange, a program of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). Through WUE, students in western states (AK, AZ, CA, HI, ID, MT, NV, NM, ND, OR, SD, UT, WA, WY, Guam and Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands) may enroll in many two-year and four-year college programs at a reduced tuition level: 150 percent of the institution's regular resident tuition. WUE tuition is considerably less than non-resident tuition. For the most current tuition information please go to msudenver.edu/cost.

WUE Eligibility

WUE is open to students who meet both MSU Denver admission and WUE program requirements. Qualified students must apply and be admitted to MSU Denver and apply for WUE **before the start of the first semester** and must complete the following application. WUE includes these participating states (AK, AZ, CA, HI, ID, MT, NV, NM, ND, OR, SD, UT, WA, WY, Guam and Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands).

By requesting the WUE program below you are indicating that you are not a Colorado resident and will not establish Colorado residency during your time of attendance at Metropolitan State University of Denver. If you plan on establishing your residency in Colorado and would like to petition for in-state benefits at Metropolitan State University of Denver during your time of attendance, it is recommended you **do not participate in the WUE program**. WUE students who change their residence to Colorado lose their WUE eligibility the following semester, but do not become eligible for in-state tuition rates until **one year** after establishing Colorado domicile and one year after discontinuing their WUE status. Because students under 23 are deemed to have the domicile of their parents, the WUE student seeking to change domicile to Colorado must show either: a change of the parents' residence; or a change in the student's residence after emancipation from the parents.
