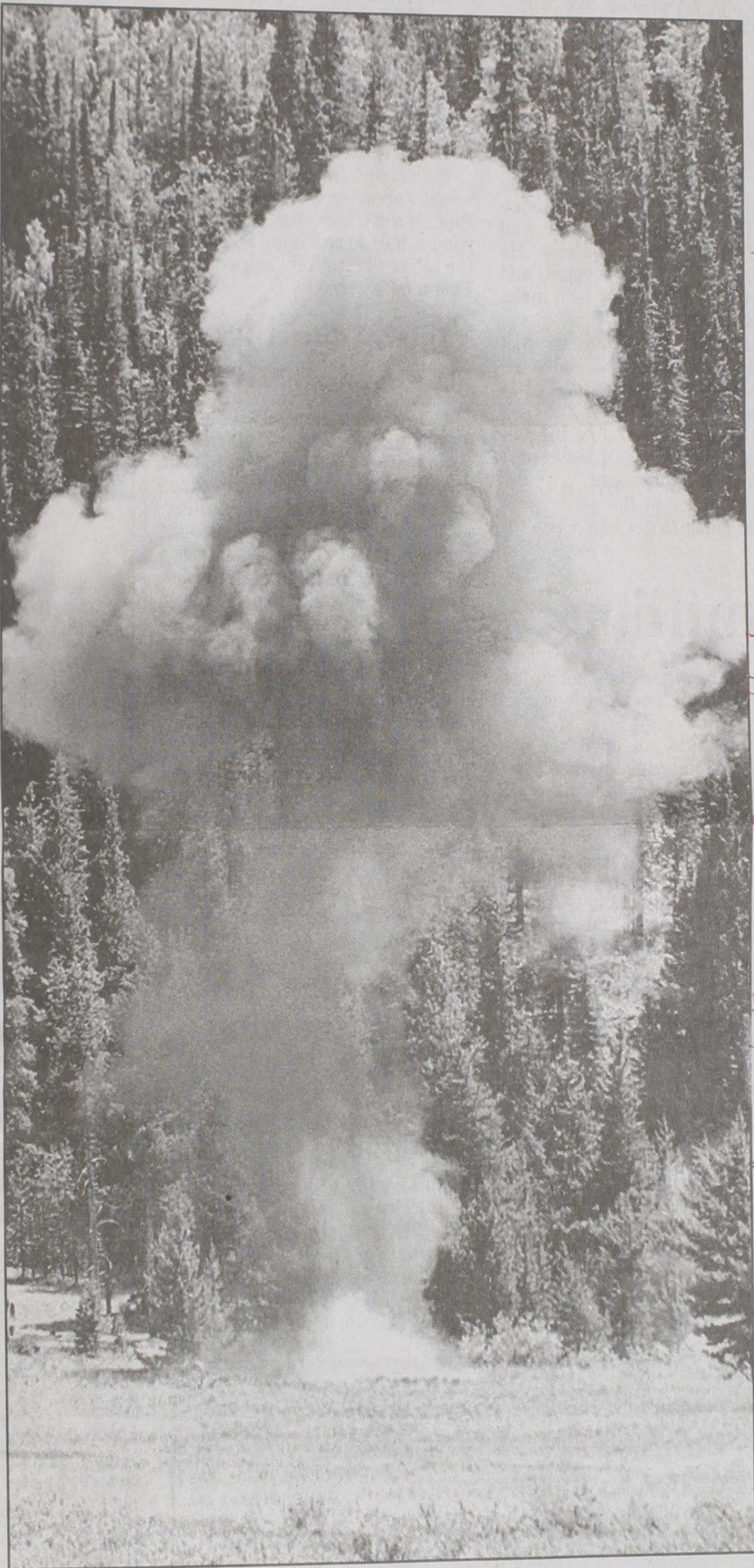


# WWII ordnance destroyed

Two pieces of World War II-era ordnance found at Camp Hale near Minturn are detonated Thursday. The destruction of a 2-inch bazooka round and a 3½-inch rocket motor allowed the Forest Service to lift a closure on 3 miles of the Continental Divide Trail and the East Fork Campground. Fort Carson's 76th Ordnance Company blew up the items with C-4 explosive.
