Here's a Test Your Students Will LOVE!

Help students get a better understanding of who they are and where their passions might lie. Career Services offers several assessments, such as the Strong Interest Inventory, the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator and StrengthsFinder, to help students understand how their personal attributes might influence their career decisions. For a small fee, these tools can be useful in helping students narrow down majors and future career options.

Trained career counselors interpret the assessment results and provide guidance on how students can use the information to move forward in their career planning. Assessments are not intended to be “crystal balls,” but help uncover attributes that a student may not have considered when making career choices.
