



### **Applicants Considering Working in States Other than Colorado**

The CCMLS Medical Laboratory Science (MLS) program is nationally accredited by the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Science and prepares graduates both academically and clinically to successfully work in the nation's clinical laboratories. Completion of the CCMLS MLS program does not guarantee that a graduate will meet specific state licensure requirements. CCMLS does not alter its curriculum for individual students seeking specific state licensure requirements.

Students who want to work in a state other than Colorado that requires licensure for clinical laboratory personnel in addition to ASCP BOC certification should contact that state licensing agency for information on the state's personnel requirements. The Colorado Center for Medical Laboratory Science (CCMLS) graduates are eligible to sit for the ASCP Board of Certification exam upon successful completion of the program.
