

## METRO MERITUS

Through the Metro Meritus program, individuals 60 years and over can attend MSU Denver classes on the main or south campuses on a space-available basis. Classes are audited, which means no testing, no written assignments, no grades, and no entry on a transcript.

The following types of classes are excluded: Classes with fees attached, non-credit, correspondence, art studio, private music instruction, self-paced, online classes, and telecourses. Courses requiring a laboratory, the use of specialized equipment, or field trips are excluded from the program, as are Master's level courses.

### **How to Get Involved (Procedures)**

1. **Paperwork:** The Metro Meritus registration form (page 2) can be obtained from the Center for Individualized Learning, in the Administration Building, on the third floor in room 360, or online at [www.msudenver.edu/cil](http://www.msudenver.edu/cil) (click on the “Metro Meritus – Lifelong Learning” link in the dark blue box on the left side of the screen).
2. **Getting into Class:** Bring the registration form to the first class meeting. Introduce yourself to the instructor and explain to him/her that you are interested in auditing the class under the Metro Meritus program. If the instructor approves, get his/her signature on the registration form. **NOTE: Sometimes you may have to attend the first few classes to determine if space will be available.** Return your signed registration form to the Center for Individualized Learning, in the Administration Building, on the third floor in room 360.
3. **Parking:** There is a fee for parking in all Auraria lots on the main campus. There is no charge for parking at the south campus. RTD offers light rail and bus service to the Auraria campus, 303-299-6000. Call for information about the route and schedule you need.
4. **Library Access:** Metro Meritus participants may use the Auraria Library. It is open to anyone from the community. You must have a Colorado ID or a Colorado driver's license.
5. **Special Access:** Access to the Accessibility Van, which provides students transportation to classes on the Auraria campus, is arranged through the Access Center at 303-615-0200. Please identify yourself as a Metro Meritus student when you contact them.
