Next to each statement is the overall positive and negative response for all respondents. Under each demographic is the number of respondents (N) and the (%) of respondents who fall into the category. For example, there were 852 respondents who were male at birth which is 31.2% of responses. If there were less than 5 responses in a given demographic the responses were removed from the report. In total there were 2,424 respondents who identified as pursuing a bachelor's degree.	
There are 5 statements where the normally positive responses of agree or strongly agree are considered negative. These statements are considered to have an inverse relationship to the rest of the statements. For this report these statements have been recoded to be in alignment with the rest of the statements. The statements can be found in the data details sections and are highlighted in gray throughout the report.

<u>Over all Highlights</u>	
The overall positive rating for all statements for all demographics is 74%. The overall negative rating for all statements for all demographics is 9%.	
Potential areas that need attention are statements where the positive response rate is less than or equal to 54% and/or the negative response rate is greater than or equal to 19%. (According to the scale provided by Modern Think)

<b>Personal</b>	
I have been able to find balance between academics and extracurricular activities/other responsibilities, Positive response: 54%, Negative response: 16%	
I know where to turn if I am overwhelmed or stressed, Positive response: 53%, Negative response: 22%	
<b>Bullying</b>	
I am [not] aware of other students at this institution who have experienced bullying at MSU Denver, Positive response: 70%, Negative response: 23%	
<b>Diversity Experience</b>	
I have had meaningful and honest discussions about race/ethnic relations outside of class with students from a racial/ethnic group other than my own, Positive response: 64%, Negative response: 23%	
I have [not] had guarded, cautious interactions with students from a racial/ethnic group other than my own, Positive response: 48%, Negative response: 34%	
I have shared personal feeling and problems with students from a racial/ethnic group other than my own, Positive response: 63%, Negative response: 23%	
There are 49 areas for celebration, 78% of all statements. This is when the percent positive response rate is greater than 75% or the negative response rate is less than 10%. The statements are noted with green highlighting throughout the report.

The statements where a "disagree to strongly disagree" is a positive response and a "agree to strongly agree" is a negative response are:	
<b>Bullying</b>	
I have experienced bullying (i.e., the persistent use of aggressive, overbearing, or unreasonable behaviors) directed toward me by a member of the MSU Denver community.	
I am aware of other students at this institution who have experienced bullying at MSU Denver.	
<b>Diversity Experience</b>	
I have had guarded, cautious interactions with students from a racial/ethnic group other than my own.	
I have had tense, somewhat hostile interactions with students from a racial/ethnic group other than my own.	
I have felt insulted or threatened because of my race/ethnicity with students from a racial/ethnic group other than my own.	

Less than 1% of respondents are 17 or under
The majority of respondents, 72.3%, are between 18 and 29
<b>First time or transfer</b>
59% of responded transferred to MSU Denver from another institution
Students who started at MSU Denver have slightly higher average rates in the themes of diversity and community than students who transferred into MSU Denver
<b>First generation status</b>
51.8% of respondents would be classified as first generation by not having had one or more parent or guardian earned a bachelor's degree
Respondents who would <b>not</b> be classified as first generation have a lower positive response and higher negative response to the statement, "I know where to turn if I am overwhelmed or stressed" (in the theme of personal)
Respondents who would <b>not</b> be classified as first generation have a lower positive response and higher negative response to the statement, "I would recommend MSU Denver on a social non-academic basis to a friend or family member" (in the theme of community)
<b>Credits taking this semester</b>
Respondents taking 17 or more credits have a higher positive response rate and lower negative response rate to the statement, "I have regular opportunities to interact with faculty members on activities other than coursework (committees, orientation, student life, etc.)" than those taking few credits (in the theme of academic)
<b>Race</b>
19.9% of respondents are Hispanic or Latino
55.7% of respondents are white
Respondents who are American Indian or Alaskan Native have lower average positive responses in the themes of academics and personal than other respondents
Respondent who are Hispanic or Latino have the highest average positive response rate, 82.2% in the theme of community
<b>Hispanic or Latino</b>
26.3% of respondents identify as having Hispanic or Latino origin
Across all themes respondents who identify as having Hispanic or Latino origin have slightly higher positive average rates and slightly lower negative average rates across most themes
<b>Credits completed</b>
Respondents who have not completed any credits have higher average positive rates in the themes of academics, personal, diversity, leadership, and communication
