Electives in the Major: 21 credits

Select a minimum of 21 credits of additional coursework in the major. At least 9 of these credits must be in upper-division courses that have an ART prefix and must be completed before the senior experience. ART 3701 Professional Practices II may be taken as an elective in the major, but may not be applied to this 9 credit ART requirement. Students are encouraged to include at least one course designated as integrated media.

Prerequisites apply. Students pursuing the BA in Art may not enroll in ART 4701, ARTH 4710, CDES 4600, CDES 4625, CDES 4650, CDES 4700, or CDES 4721, or in courses with an ARTE prefix. Certain other advanced ART and CDES courses may be available only to BFA students.
