

Upload an Unlisted Video to YouTube from a Computer

1. Create a YouTube account if you do not already have one.
2. Click the “Create” button in the upper right corner. It looks like a tiny video camera with a plus. Choose “Upload video.”
3. Drag and drop video file or select video file (like an attachment).
4. On the next screen, add the title and description. You will also be required to identify if it’s made for children (choose No). Click Next.
5. The next screen asks about other video elements to add; do not add anything here and click Next.
6. On the next screen, under save or publish, **choose Unlisted**. Click Save.
7. The channel will let you know that it is processing the video. This usually takes a few minutes depending on the size and quality of the video and the connection speed.
8. To share the link, hover over the video you just uploaded and it will turn grey. A menu of options will also appear. There will be an option of three vertical dots. If you click on this, you will get a prompt for a shareable link. This is the link that can be used to share the video. Copy and paste it to a document for easy access while you fill out your audition application.
9. Repeat these steps for your other two videos. Once you have the three links, you are ready to begin your online audition application.
