CONDUCT & BEHAVIOR STANDARDS

The following rules apply to every Sol Education Abroad participant. By signing this form, you are acknowledging your understanding of these rules along with the acknowledgement that they apply during all phases of your program participation. Keep a copy of the Conduct and Behavior Standards for future reference. Additionally, we advise that you share this with family, friends, emergency contacts and any other interested individuals who are assisting you with your choice to study abroad.

Obeying US & Foreign Laws

Students must adhere to the laws of the country where they are studying. Students must be sensitive to the host culture and agree to behave appropriately and as directed by our on-site staff. By signing this form you are verifying that you will not be involved in any illegal behavior.

Prohibited Behavior & Personal Safety

Students must not engage in any behavior that may be harmful to their health and safety nor engage in any behavior that may be detrimental to other students on the program. Any such behavior may result in expulsion from the program. Students will be respectful of the rules and regulations of the school and their classes. Any aggressive or disrespectful behavior towards teachers will be dealt with appropriately. In extreme cases a student will have their classes cancelled or be sent home without a refund. Students will be respectful of all Sol Education Abroad staff. Students will be respectful of each other. For their own safety, students are encouraged to avoid walking around after dark, even in groups.

Alcohol & Drug Policy

Students must obey all US laws, state laws, and laws of the country where they are studying regarding the possession, use, transfer or consumption of drugs as well as any other illegal behavior. By signing this form you are verifying that you will not be involved in any illegal activity during your study abroad program, including the possession, use, transfer or consumption of illegal drugs. **If you do become involved in such activity, it may result in immediate expulsion from the program.** As a Sol Education Abroad participant, you are subject to the rules and requirements of the program.

Alcohol is not allowed in hotel rooms or on any transportation used by the program during program excursions or activities. Students may be denied participation in the activity without a refund if they arrive to the excursion intoxicated. **They may also be dismissed from the program for a violation of this policy.**

If you are arrested for alcohol or drug use while overseas **it is not the legal responsibility** of Sol Education Abroad.

SOL EDUCATION ABROAD PROCEDURES FOR VIOLATION OF CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR STANDARDS:

Incident Report

If it is suspected that you have violated the Conduct and Behavior Standards the on-site staff will discuss this with. The on-site staff will write a formal incident report to document the alleged violation.

Dismissal

Violating any of the Conduct and Behavior Standards may result in immediate expulsion and dismissal from the Sol Education Abroad program, without prior warnings. If you must return to the US due to program expulsion, it will be at your expense and no refund will be issued. The decision for expulsion is made by the Sol Education Abroad executive

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directors and is in their sole discretion. Once a decision is made for expulsion, the staff will assist you in making travel arrangements. Any expenses incurred for return transportation will be your responsibility.
