

Pikes Peak Community College AA in Social Work to MSU Denver Social Work Major Transfer Plan

The Social Work major at MSU Denver is a Fall start only Program. Students will begin taking upper division Social Work courses in the Fall semester after they are accepted into the Program and after all prerequisites are completed. At least one of these prerequisites must be taken at MSU Denver. Therefore, students should apply to the Program in the Spring semester, and transfer to MSU Denver no later than the summer before they intend on starting the major.
