Cost of Auditing Courses

Students auditing courses on Main Campus will be charged the "Total Tuition" and "Mandatory Fees" and will not be eligible for COF Stipend.

50% tuition discount from 13 to 18 credit hours

At MSU Denver, undergraduate students will receive 50% tuition rate discount that applies towards 13th - 18th credit hours only, if classes are taken on the **same campus**.*

* Same campus means:

- All Main Campus courses;
- A mix of Main Campus & Online courses; or
- All South Campus courses

Health & Wellness Fee: This fee funds a portion of the Health Center at Auraria and the MSU Denver Counseling Center operating budgets. Fees support the cost of campus safety infrastructure, medical and mental health personnel and health education.

Clean Energy Fee: This student-approved fee is for purchasing clean, renewable, electrical power for the Auraria Campus

Phoenix Center Fee: This student approved fee is used to support the Phoenix Center at Auraria (PCA). The Center is a victim advocacy program providing free, confidential resources and assistance.

Metro Bond Fee: This student approved fee will provide capital financing for the construction of a new Metropolitan State University Neighborhood, student scholarships, and student equipment and classroom enhancements.

Student Affairs Fee: This fee supports student services through the following programs: Auraria Early Learning Center, Career Services, Club Sports, Center for Visual Arts, Institute for Women's Studies and Services, LGBTQ Student Resource Center, Music, Student Activities, Student Engagement and Wellness, Student Government, Student Media, Student Organization Funding, Student Travel, and Theatre.

Technology Fee: This fee makes possible design/accessibility enhancements to existing online courses, expansion of online student services (enrollment, advising, tutoring, testing, career services), faculty training for online instruction, development of new courses, creation of fully-online programs, and support for online education technology. This fee will also support, maintain, and enhance technology and software in classrooms, labs, and on-line learning environments.

Matriculation Fee (One-time fee): \$100 for Undergraduate students (charged to ALL students including non-degree seeking and students auditing courses). The matriculation fee is used to offset orientation, student ID card, and graduation costs. This fee is not included in the Tuition and Fees Table, but will appear on the billing statement.

Program Fees
