MANDATORY STUDENT FEES

Student Affairs Fee

This fee enhances the college experience for Metro State students. The fee covers the cost of various campus activities and organizations students participate in.

Athletic Fee

This allows Metro State students free access to all Metro State intercollegiate sporting events. This fee funds the operating budget for Metro's NCAA-II intercollegiate athletic program, which consists of five women's and five men's varsity teams. It also allows students to use the Athletic Facilities as well.

Health Services Fee

The Health Center is funded exclusively by student fees and self-generated income. The Health Services fee supports the cost of medical personnel, associated operating expenses and health education programming/outreach. Charges for services are assessed at a significantly reduced rate compared to private sector fees.

Registration Fee

This fee is used to support and maintain the web registration system used by students to register for classes as well as retrieve grades and obtain other useful information.

AHEC Facility and Bond Fee

This fee is used to support the debt service requirements of the debt financing for the Auraria Child Care Center, the Tivoli Student Union and the Auraria Event Center.

Information Technology Fee

This fee is used to support and maintain the various computer labs located on campus that are available for use by all registered students upon presentation of a current Metro State ID.

Bus Pass Fee

Approved by the vote of the student bodies of Metro State, UCD, and CCD, this fee allows a registered student of each of these institutions to ride the RTD free or at a discounted rate upon presentation of a current student ID.

Clean Energy Fee

This student approved fee is for purchasing clean renewable electrical power for the Auraria Campus.

Matriculation Fee (one time only fee)

The matriculation fee, used to offset records, orientation, graduation and transcript costs, is charged to all students as a part of their tuition and fees bill for their first registration. This fee is not included in the Tuition and Mandatory Fees Schedule, but will be included on your billing/confirmation statement.
