Additional out of state tuition charge per credit hour in excess of 18 credit hours is \$514.30

Non-Resident students can avoid cancellation by payment in full, or signed payment contract in our office, CN110, by payment deadline. (Regardless of Financial Aid eligibility)

Additional tuition charge per credit hour in excess of 18 credit hours is \$118.75 for stipend eligible and \$186.75 for stipend ineligible courses.

Students taking online classes pay an Internet Class fee of \$23.89 per credit hour. Students registered exclusively for online classes will be charged tuition, the internet class fee, the student affairs fee, the registration fee, the immunization fee, Metro bond fee and the information technology fee.

Students registered exclusively for the Aurora and Front Range Community College classes will be charged tuition, bus pass fee, registration fee, information technology fee, Metro bond fee and immunization fee.

For students at the Front Range Community College the additional fees of Front Range Activity Fee will be assessed at \$4.70 per credit hour, along with a \$3.00 Parking Fee per credit hour, capped at 12 credit hours. In addition, students will be charged a flat Front Range Program Fee of \$110.70 and a Front Range Bond Fee of \$30.00.

For students at the Community College of Aurora the additional fees of CCA Bond Fee will be assessed at \$2.00 per credit hour, along with a \$1.05 Parking Fee per credit hour, capped at 12 credit hours. In addition, students will be charged a flat Program Fee of \$110.70 and an ACC Student Activity Fee of \$17.00.

**Student Affairs Fee**

This fee covers the cost of various campus activities and organizations in which students participate. The appropriation of this fee can be seen in greater detail within the student handbook.

**Athletic Fee**

This fee allows Metro State students free access to all Metro State intercollegiate sporting events. This fee also funds the operating budget for Metro State's NCAA-II intercollegiate athletic program, which consists of five women's and five men's varsity teams.

**Health Services Fee**

The Health Center is funded exclusively by student fees and self-generated income. The Health Services fee supports the cost of medical personnel, associated operating expenses, and health education programming/outreach. Charges for services are assessed at a significantly reduced rate compared to private sector fees.

**Registration Fee**

This fee is used to support and maintain the web registration system used by students to register for classes, as well as retrieve grades and obtain other useful information.

**Immunization Fee**

This fee supports the Auraria Health Center's efforts in providing immunization to students against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella. The program is necessary in order for the institution to remain in compliance with State Immunization Rules.

**AHEC Facility and Bond Fee**

This fee is used to support the debt service requirements of the debt financing for the Auraria Child Care Center, the Tivoli Student Union and the Auraria Event Center.

**Metro Bond Fee**

This student approved fee will provide capital financing for the construction of a new Metropolitan State College Neighborhood.

**Information Technology Fee**

This fee is used to support and maintain student-based technology services available to all registered students. These services include (but not limited to) student email accounts and general-access student labs

**Bus Pass Fee**

Approved by vote of the student body at Metro State, UCD, and CCD, this fee allows registered students of each institution to ride the RTD free upon presentation of a current Metro State ID.

**Clean Energy Fee**

This student-approved fee is for purchasing clean, renewable, electrical power for the Auraria Campus.

**Matriculation Fee (one time fee, \$50):**

The matriculation fee is a one-time fee, used to offset orientation, graduation and transcript costs, is charged to all students as a part of their tuition and fees. This fee is not included in the Tuition and Fee schedule, but will be included on the billing statement.
