- Additional tuition charge per credit hour in excess of 18 credit hours for stipend eligible courses as a Resident is \$158.70 when the Stipend is applied to the account, or \$220.70 for stipend ineligible courses. Additional tuition charge per credit hour in excess of 18 credit hours for a Non-Resident is \$611.05 and for a Wiche-Wue student is \$331.05.

- Students enrolled in the 3+2 Accountancy Program that are enrolled in graduate level courses will be assessed a \$166.30 Graduate Course Fee per credit hour.

- Non-Resident students can avoid registration cancellation by payment in full or having a signed contract on file by payment deadline; regardless of Financial Aid or third-party eligibility. Payment contracts can be found online via the MetroConnect portal, under the My Services/Registration tab and by clicking on the Student Financial Services tab.

- Students registered exclusively for the Aurora and Front Range Community College classes will be charged the Student's Share of Tuition, Bus Pass Fee, Metro Bond Fee, Immunization Fee and a Program Fee at the flat rate of \$110.70.

- Students taking classes at Front Range Community College will be charged an additional Activity Fee assessed at \$4.78 per credit hour and a Bond Fee at the flat rate of \$30.00.

- Students taking classes at the Community College of Aurora will be charged an additional Parking Fee assessed at \$1.05 per credit hour (capped at 12 credit hours), a Bond Fee assessed at \$2.00 per credit hour, and an Activity Fee at the flat rate of \$17.30.

- Students registered exclusively for online classes will be charged the Student's Share of Tuition, Student Affairs Fee, Immunization Fee and Metro Bond Fee.

This scale is for Main Campus courses. If a student has Extended Campus courses in addition to Main Campus, this scale only applies to the credit hours taken at the Main Campus.

Student Affairs Fee: This fee covers the cost of various campus activities and organizations in which students participate. The appropriation of this fee can be seen in greater detail within the student handbook.

Intercollegiate Athletic Fee: This fee allows Metro State students free access to all Metro State intercollegiate sporting events. This fee also funds the operating budget for Metro State's NCAA-II intercollegiate athletic program, which consists of five women's and five men's varsity teams.

Health Services Fee: The Health Center is funded exclusively by student fees and self-generated income. The Health Services fee supports the cost of medical personnel, associated operating expenses, and health education programming/outreach. Charges for services are assessed at a significantly reduced rate compared to private sector fees.

Immunization Fee: This fee supports the Auraria Health Center's efforts in providing immunization to students against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella. The program is necessary in order for the institution to remain in compliance with State Immunization Rules.

AHEC Facility and Bond Fee: This fee is used to support the debt service requirements of the debt financing for the Auraria Child Care Center, the Tivoli Student Union and the Auraria Event Center.

Metro Bond Fee: This student approved fee will provide capital financing for the construction of a new Metropolitan State College Neighborhood.

RTD Pass Fee: Approved by vote of the student body at Metro State, UCD, and CCD, this fee allows registered students of each institution to ride the RTD free upon presentation of a current Metro State ID and current semester sticker.

Clean Energy Fee: This student-approved fee is for purchasing clean, renewable, electrical power for the Auraria Campus.

Matriculation Fee (one time fee, \$50): The matriculation fee is a one-time fee (per degree program), used to offset orientation, graduation and transcript costs, is charged to all students as a part of their tuition and fees. This fee is not included in the Tuition and Fee schedule, but will be included on the billing statement.
