

## **Full-Year 2019-2020 Graduates Information based on first and second majors**

Note that 17.1% of the bachelor graduates were in the College of Business, 2.7% were in the School of Education, 33.8% were in the College of Letters, Arts and Sciences, 31.7% were in the College of Professional Studies, 4.8% were in the Individualized Degree Program, 7.8% were Master's Programs, and 2.2% were in Certificate Programs.

The top 10 majors were: Biology (189); Psychology (177); Individualized Degree Program (167); Accounting (146); Master of Social Work (144); Criminal Justice & Criminology (142); Management (141); Nursing (114); English (102); and Marketing (88). These majors account for 40.5% of all graduates.

Males accounted for 41.60% and females accounted for 58.40% of all graduates.

Graduates of Color accounted for 36.11% of all graduates. Hispanics or Latino (21.83), Black or African Americans (4.17%), Asians (4.94%), American Indian or Alaskan Natives (0.37%), Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islanders (0.29%), and Two or More Races (4.51%).

Note that Full-Year 2016-17 was the largest graduating class for MSU Denver of 3,674 which is 193 more than 2019-2020. Includes 218 Master's Program degrees and 74 Certificate programs.

Full-Year 2019-2020 we had 3,481 total, includes 3,134 Bachelor programs, 271 Master's Program degrees and 76 Certificate programs.

STEM majors account for 29.6% of all graduates.
