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Respondent Characteristics & Distributions

Report Introduction

This report provides key information regarding who responded to the survey and what they reported overall. This report is made up of three different table types. First, the Response Rates table shows the response rate (AAPOR RR2) (The American Association for Public Opinion Research. 2011. *Standard Definitions: Final Dispositions of Case Codes and Outcome Rates for Surveys. 7th edition.* AAPOR) for your school compared with the overall study and your comparison groups. Response rates by demographic categories (Gender, Race, and Class Standing) are also given if data were provided in the school sample. The Basic Response Distribution portion of this report is helpful for understanding the degree to which your sample mirrors both your institution's full undergraduate population as well as the samples against which you are comparing data (i.e., the comparison groups that you selected to appear in the report). And lastly, the Respondent Distribution Across Variables section provides sample sizes and distributions for most survey items.

Reading the Tables

Please consider the following when reviewing tables:

- The blue column in each table represents the results for your random sample respondents only.
- Cells populated with a period indicate that an insufficient number of respondents, less than 15, answered that particular question for analyses to be conducted. The MSL requires 15 cases for a statistic to be reported to ensure respondent confidentiality as well as appropriate interpretations of the data are made. Basing a finding off of fewer than 15 cases may lead to erroneous conclusions.

Response Rates Tables

This table describes the response rates for your general population sample, the MSL national sample, and other comparison groups pre-selected by your institution for inclusion in this report. These statistics are generated using the data that you provided to us along with student contact information prior to data collection. If you were not able to provide some or all of this data, you will see no data here. The statistics reported are percentages of those who responded (partially or completely) to the survey from among all those invited. For example, if you see the value 29.8 listed under Gender: Male, that means that 29.8% of your males (as defined by the data you provided with your sample file) responded to the survey. These data are useful for identifying patterns of response rate at your school.
