Secondary Placement Process:

If you need to take the secondary placement, please come to the English Department, King Center 402, between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. Tell the office that you need to take the secondary placement for First Year Writing. The assessment will take 45-60 minutes. Once your placement has been scored, the department will contact you by email and let you know whether you have been placed into ENG 1008 and ENG 1009 (two semester sequence), ENG 1010 and ENG 1001 (both in one semester), or ENG 1010. You will need to respond to the email to be registered. **You may also take the placement in the Testing Services Office, Tivoli 347. See their website for hours.**
