New Student Checklist

- Apply for your VA Education Benefits**
 - Apply Online www.ebenefits.va.gov/ebenefits
 - Veterans and Service Members submit VA Form 22-1990 for Post 9/11, Montgomery or REAP
 - Dependent Transfer of Post 9/11 submit VA Form 22-1990E
 - Dependents using DEA or Fry Scholarship submit VA form 22-5490
 - Provide a copy of your Certificate of Eligibility (COE) letter to the Veterans Benefits Office at the Registrar.

 - Apply Online www.ebenefits.va.gov/ebenefits
 - Submit 22-1995 for Post 9/11, Transfer of Post 9/11, Montgomery and REAP
 - Submit 22-5495 for Dependent Education Assistance Program and Fry Scholarship

- Transcripts**
 - Send all previous college and university official transcripts to Admissions
 - Submit your DD214 to Admissions for Credit Review
 - Request your military transcripts and have it reviewed by the Prior Learning Specialist
