The MAT candidate in elementary education will complete requirements for licensure in the K-6 classroom. Students can complete the content courses and requisite licensure requirements while working towards a graduate degree to fulfill the Elementary Education requirements. Candidates who are interested in the program are required to have completed a baccalaureate degree. Candidates will meet with a MAT Elementary Education advisor to determine a program plan of study.

All teacher licensure candidates at MSU Denver must pass an approved licensure/content exam as a part of their degree program. Talk with your faculty advisor upon admission to the MAT Elementary Education program regarding which exam(s) you must take and the timeline for taking the exam(s).
