AES

Enrollment procedures for AES Department students:

1. All incoming freshmen and transfer students must attend a college orientation and assessment session and should be advised by an AES Department faculty member.
2. AES academic advising will be held on an appointment basis.
3. The enrollment process must be completed in the sequence above.
4. In order to register for a 3000 or 4000 level course, each of the following conditions must be satisfied:
 - a) At time of registration, students must be classified as a junior (at least 60 semester hours completed and/or transfer work posted to the academic record);
 - b) All prerequisite courses must have been completed and posted to the academic record or currently in progress.
 - c) Prerequisite courses in progress must be satisfactorily completed ('C' grade or better) or students will be dropped from upper division courses.
 - d) If at the time of registration, these requirements have not been satisfied, the student must contact the

department. Registration by exception will be done at the AES Department Office.

5. Students who fail to attend the first two meetings of a class will be dropped and may not rejoin that class without permission of the instructor.

6. Students should note that the Aviation and Aerospace Science faculty assigned to each class in this schedule are subject to change without notice, due to availability and scheduling requirements.
