

SPEECH, LANGUAGE, HEARING SCIENCES: B.A. DEGREE

This major provides a sound background for students pursuing careers in education, health care, and vocational rehabilitation. Graduates with the SLHS major will have the prerequisite coursework to pursue a [graduate degree in speech-language pathology \(SLP\)](#) or audiology, which opens careers in schools, community clinics, hospitals, rehabilitation centers, and private practice. 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Additional Course Work Considerations:

- Students majoring in SLHS must complete a minor.
- Students must earn a grade of C or better in all major courses to count towards the B.A. in SLHS.
- Students who apply to an SLP graduate program must complete 3 additional college-level classes: 1) a physics or chemistry course; 2) a statistics course; 3) a social/behavioral science course (e.g. intro to psychology). Biological science coursework (BIO 1080/1090) is already incorporated into the SLHS degree plan.
