


How to Pay with a 529 Savings Plan

The steps below illustrate how a student/beneficiary or parent makes a payment using a 529 Savings Plan.


- 1. Log in the StudentHub and click "Pay Tuition" link or to the Authorized Payer portal.
- 2. In the site's navigation, click Make a Payment.

- 3. Select the item(s) for purchase, enter the amount, and click Continue.
- 4. In the Select Method of Payment screen, click New 529 Savings Plan.


Figure 2: New 529 Savings Plan Payment Method






5. From the dropdown menu, select your 529 savings plan.

6. Provide the 529 account number and agree to the 529 terms.


Figure 4: Entering 529 Information






7. In the 529 Savings Plan modal window that loads, enter your username and password, and click Log On.

Figure 6: 529 Savings Plan Authorization






The modal window closes, and Cashnet displays a message about the service fee.


9. Click Continue to accept the service fee and make the payment.

If the payment is authorized, a confirmation message displays, showing your remaining balance.


Figure 8: 529 Payment Confirmation
