Three Ways to Qualify for **Guaranteed Admission**

MSU Denver firmly believes in equitable access to higher education. You will qualify for guaranteed admission if you meet any one of the three items below:

- Have a cumulative unweighted high school GPA of 2.6 or higher OR
- Are 20 years old or older and graduated from high school or have received qualifying GED scores OR
- Have at least 24 transferable college credits (transfer students)



Application Review

Don't qualify for guaranteed admission? MSU Denver reviews all other applicants holistically for admission and admits many students with a wide range of academic backgrounds. In addition to your application, our holistic application review will consider:


