- Budget Recommendation Committee | Braedan
  - o 1/21/2021 No Update
- Road Runner Safer Return | Braedan
  - o 1/21/2021
    - New Federal dollars are on their way to MSU Denver
      - \$26M, with \$17.1M of that being used for student aid
    - Changes have been made to the current health protocols regarding appropriate face coverings
      - Face shields, buffs, bandanas, etc. no longer accepted unless specifically approved by the Health Center
      - Projected timeframes of phase vaccinations (\*subject to change)
        - Phase 1B: Jan-Feb
        - Phase 1C: March-May
        - Phase 2: June-July
        - Phase 3: July-Dec
        - At this time household members of MSU-D
        - faculty/staff/students are not included in vaccination planning
- Academic Policy Committee | Stephanie
  - **Passed December 2<sup>nd</sup>:** Double Dipping: The AVP for Curriculum and Academic Policy Development identified several General Studies related policies that do <u>not</u> closely align with §23-1-125(1) C.R.S. resulting in the following changes:
    - All associate degrees from regionally accredited institutions need to receive full general studies credit

- Programs cannot proscribe required general studies courses
- Removal of policy banning students from taking general studies courses with the same major prefix
