Admissions Planning





Admissions Dates & Deadlines

- The MSW Advanced Standing Program is summer-start only and has one admissions cycle annually
- The MSW Regular Program is <u>fall-start only</u> and has one admissions cycle annually
- Applicants should plan on applying the fall and winter before the semester they wish to start





Admissions Dates & Deadlines

- The 2021 MSW Admissions Cycle opened on September 8, 2020
- Final Application Deadline: Thursday, January 14, 2021 at 11:59 PM (Mountain Time)
- Application Processing takes 10-12 weeks after the deadline
- Applicants are notified of decisions via email





Priority Admission

- Priority Consideration Deadline: Thursday, October 29, 2020 at 11:59 PM (Mountain Time)
- Applications will be reviewed during the fall and winter by the MSW Admissions Committee
- Those ranked in the top of the applicant pool will be granted early admission





Admissions Eligibility

Regular Program

- Have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher*
- Completion of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university prior to the start of the fall 2020 term
- Undergraduate course prerequisite completion (prior to the start of MSW Program courses)
- Submission of all required application materials

Advanced Standing Program

 Hold a degree completed within 6 years from the intended MSW Program start semester that is:

From a baccaulaureate social work program accredited by CSWE

Recognized through CSWE's International Social Work Degree Recognition & Evaluation Service

From a program that is covered under a memorandum of understanding with international social work accreditors

- Have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher*
- Submission of all required application materials






GPA of Accepted Students

Over the past five application cycles, on average:


Cumulative GPA of Accepted Regular Program Students

The **final application deadline** for the 2021 Admissions Cycle is **January 14, 2021 at 11:59 PM**. All required materials must be submitted by this date and time for an application to be considered complete and eligible for review.

To be considered for priority admission, applicants must have all required application materials submitted by October 29, 2020 at 11:59 PM.

Please note: Application processing takes 10-12 weeks from the deadline (not from the submission of the application) to complete. The Office of Social Work Student Services will stay in close contact with you throughout the entire process. 



Unofficial Transcripts: Due to the global COVID-19 pandemic, the Office of Graduate Studies at MSU Denver will accept unofficial transcripts for admission to any of our graduate programs. Students submitting unofficial transcripts will be "Admitted with Requirements." The requirements are that official transcripts from each university attended must be received by MSU Denver prior to the end of your first term of graduate study and/or when the COVID-19 crisis subsides. If you do not submit an official transcript by the end of your first term, you will receive a hold on your student record and you may be withdrawn from courses during your second term of study. If the COVID-19 pandemic extends beyond your first term of study at MSU Denver you may appeal to the Office of Graduate Studies for an extension of your "admission with requirements" stipulation.

If you would like to take advantage of "the Admitted with Requirements" option now, one unofficial transcript from each university attended must be uploaded within your application or application status page. All unofficial transcripts must be uploaded for your application to be reviewed by the graduate program for which you are applying. Please do not mail unofficial transcripts as part of your admission application; we only accept unofficial uploads for application evaluation.





Step Three: Submit Official Transcripts

- Must submit from all colleges and universities attended
- COVID-19 Note: Strongly encourage submission of transcripts electronically at this time due to mail delays
- See our website for detailed instructions and information on what to do if you:
 - Attended a college or university outside of the United States (not as part of a study abroad program)
 - Obtained an undergraduate degree from MSU Denver
 - Previously submitted official transcripts to our office or MSU Denver





Step Four: Undergraduate Prerequisite Review (RP Only)

- After you submit transcripts, email us to request a prerequisite review (can also be request earlier with submission of unofficial transcripts via email – see website for instructions)
- MSW Regular Program Prerequisite Requirements:
 - 3 credits of course work in social and behavioral science centrally organized around contemporary multicultural or diversity issues
 - 3 credits of course work in social and behavioral science centrally organized around American Government
 - 3 credits of course work in human/general biology OR
 6 credits of course work in natural and physical science
 - 3 credits of course work in basic statistics
