This scale is for Main Campus courses. If a student has Extended Campus courses in addition to Main Campus, this scale only applies to the credit hours taken at the Main Campus.

Student Affairs Fee: This fee covers the cost of various campus activities and organizations in which students participate. The appropriation of this fee can be seen in greater detail within the student handbook.

Intercollegiate Athletic Fee: This fee allows MSU Denver students free access to all MSU Denver intercollegiate sporting events. This fee also funds the operating budget for MSU Denver's NCAA-II intercollegiate athletic program, which consists of five women's and five men's varsity teams.

Health Services Fee: The Health Center is funded exclusively by student fees and self-generated income. The Health Services fee supports the cost of medical personnel, associated operating expenses, and health education programming/outreach. Charges for services are assessed at a significantly reduced rate compared to private sector fees.

Immunization Fee: This fee supports the Auraria Health Center's efforts in providing immunization to students against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella. The program is necessary in order for the institution to remain in compliance with State Immunization Rules.

AHEC Facility and Bond Fee: This fee is used to support the debt service requirements of the debt financing for the Auraria Child Care Center, the Tivoli Student Union and the Auraria Event Center.

Metro Bond Fee: This student approved fee will provide capital financing for the construction of a new Metropolitan State University Neighborhood.

RTD Pass Fee: Approved by vote of the student body at MSU Denver, UCD, and CCD, this fee allows registered students of each institution to ride the RTD free upon presentation of a current MSU Denver ID and RTD CollegePass.

Clean Energy Fee: This student-approved fee is for purchasing clean, renewable, electrical power for the Auraria Campus.

Phoenix Center Fee: This student approved fee is to support the Phoenix Center at Auraria (PCA). The Center is a victim advocacy program providing free, confidential resources and assistance.

Matriculation Fee (one time fee, \$50): The matriculation fee is a one-time fee per Undergraduate and Graduate degree program. It is used to offset orientation, graduation and transcript costs, is charged to all students as a part of their tuition and fees. This fee is not included in the Tuition and Fee schedule, but will be included on the billing statement.
