Student Travel Program

The Student Travel Program is operational and accepting new student submissions for funding. At this time, students may travel to professional development events/seminars/conferences/conventions within the state of Colorado without any restrictions. Out-of-state travel requires the completion of the University mandated Travel Authorization Form (<https://roadrunnerlink.msudenver.edu/organization/student-activities/documents/view/1953290>) prior to applying for travel funding.

Each student is eligible to receive the following funding each fiscal year:

- Graduate School Entrance Exam and Professional Licensure - \$400/fiscal year
- Student Travel Program - \$625/fiscal year
- Online Professional Development - \$625/fiscal year
