You MUST provide the following **required** documentation:

- A copy of **both parents’ death certificates**.

- I am or was a **WARD OF THE COURT** as determined in my state of legal residence. This does not include an incarcerated minor.*

You MUST provide the following **required** documentation:

- A copy of a **court’s decision** of your ward of court status. The court must be located in your state of legal residence at the time the decision was issued.

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I am or was in **FOSTER CARE** at or after the age of 13.

You MUST provide the following **required documentation**:

- A copy of a **court's decision** to remove you from your household at or since the age of 13.

I made an **ERROR** on my financial aid application, due to one of the following reasons...
...My biological parents are deceased but I was adopted prior to my 13th birthday.
...I have never been an orphan, a ward of the court, or a foster youth.

You MUST complete the following **required step** to amend the error:

Login to www.fafsa.gov, and **Make FAFSA Corrections** to your existing 2022-2023 application. After updating your answer to "NO" within the "Dependency Status" tab, **you will be required to provide parental information AND a parent signature**. After making the necessary changes, be sure to submit the FAFSA for processing. You will receive a confirmation page when the submission is complete. Additional documentation may be requested.
