**Required Documentation:** A copy of your DD 214 Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty or upcoming release orders.

I am currently serving on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces for purposes other than training. Check this box only if:

- You are currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces or are a National Guard or Reserves enlistee who is on active duty for other than state or training purposes, and will continue to serve through June 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Required Documentation:** A statement from your commanding officer certifying your active duty status.

I made a mistake on my FAFSA. Check this box only if:

- You are a National Guard or Reserves enlistee activated only for state or training purposes.
- You are currently an ROTC student or a cadet or midshipman at a service academy.
- You were discharged from the military under less than honorable conditions.
- You have never engaged in active duty (including basic training) in the U.S. Armed Forces, are not a veteran, and are not an active member of the U.S. military.
