Requirements to Become an IBCLC

- 95 hours of lactation specific education
 - NUT 4950 Lactation Management provides 50 of these hours
 - NUT 4970 provides 45 of these hours
- 500 hours of directly supervised lactation specific clinical practice, NUT 4990
- Take and pass the IBCLC Exam

IBCLC Exam Information

- Offered twice/year
- Eligible for exam after all education courses and supervised hours are complete
- Held at Prometric Testing Center (Greenwood Village & Longmont)
