The BFA in Communication Design degree is an extended major; no minor is required. A grade of C- or better is required in each required course before progressing to subsequent courses. All students entering the department wishing to pursue the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) in Communication Design will be admitted under the BA in Art. Entrance into the BFA program is contingent on passing a formal portfolio review upon completing 21 credits in ART, CDES, or ARTH, inclusive of the 18 hours of foundations courses required for all students in the department. Students must earn a minimum of a 3.0 GPA in this coursework in the major at the time of portfolio review and have completed the Written Communication, Oral Communication, and Quantitative Literacy General Studies

requirements. Communication Design majors who choose to do so may minor in Art History, Theory and Criticism, a distinct discipline from Art or Communication Design, although all reside within the Department of Art and share common foundational requirements
