TREP (Teacher Recruitment and Educator Preparation) Agreement Form

You have indicated that you are interested in enrolling in the TREP program. This program allows you to take courses in an educator pathway for up to two years, immediately following your senior year of high school. A student is eligible for TREP if the student:

- Per 22-35-108.5 (2)(a)(I), C.R.S., "is following the teaching career pathway created in section 23-60-110 and is on schedule to complete the courses and/or experiences specified in the teaching career pathway for the twelfth grade year and is enrolling in the postsecondary courses identified in the teaching career pathway for the fifth and sixth years."
- Is college ready, and not in need of developmental education coursework in accordance with the education career pathway in which they enroll.
- Completes an Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP) prior to declaring intent to participate in TREP.
- Applies to, and is accepted into, MSU Denver to continue on an approved educator pathway.
- Is entering the TREP program in the year immediately following the student's 4th year of high school.
- Has been selected for participation by their school or district TREP coordinator based on the above criteria.
- Upon entry to the TREP program, has not been designated a TREP program participant in any prior year (can only participate in TREP for two academic years).
- Is in good academic standing (minimum grade point average of 2.0 in MSU Denver coursework) and remains enrolled in an applicable educator pathway in order to participate in two years of the TREP program.

To enroll at MSU Denver, a student must have completed the minimum course prerequisites and all required assessments. International students attending high school on an F1 Visa are not eligible for TREP.

- That advice and counsel regarding such participation has been received from your current high school.
- Please be aware that grades from any college courses you take through TREP will be posted to both your high school and MSU Denver transcript. Courses that you withdraw from, fail to complete, or receive a non-passing grade in may affect your ability to enroll or receive financial aid from MSU Denver in the future.
- The courses fit with your Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP).
- In compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974 and Colorado’s Student Data Transparency and Security Act, the student gives their school and district and MSU Denver permission to exchange any of their academic records and student/personal information pertinent to their participation in the TREP program, including but not limited to records/information of absences and disciplinary issues, grades, transcripts, class schedules, and billing information.
- The signatures indicate authorization of the College Opportunity Fund (COF) to MSU Denver. The student authorizes the school/district to release their State Assigned Student ID (SASID) to MSU Denver for the purpose of COF. The student needs to apply for COF and understands the MSU Denver credits will be deducted from their COF lifetime account.
- The student must meet the same course expectations and prerequisites as college students, as noted in course catalog and/or syllabus.
- Courses must satisfy MSU Denver degree requirements for the student’s major/minor and are in line with the student’s ICAP.
- Course credits may transfer in congruence with Colorado Guaranteed Transfer (GT) Pathways or statewide transfer agreements. Most colleges and universities do not give incoming transfer credit for courses below a grade of “C-.”
- Prior to adding, dropping, or withdrawing from a class, students must contact their CCHS advisor and school or district TREP coordinator. If a student withdraws from a course at MSU Denver after the drop/add date, they will receive a “W” on their MSU Denver transcript. Failure to withdraw by the withdraw date may result in the student receiving a failing grade.
- Regarding college activities, qualified students may participate in activities but are not eligible for NCAA athletic activities.
- The student understands that the school or district will hold their high school diploma until they have completed the TREP program.
- Students who wish to enroll in MSU Denver classes the summer immediately following their senior year must pay their own tuition/fees.
- The student understands that they will not be eligible for federal, state, or MSU Denver financial aid while in the TREP program.
- Students may be responsible for self-paying textbooks, materials, and MSU Denver fees.

I understand that this agreement entitles me/my student to enroll in college courses. In signing this agreement, I authorize MSU Denver to release my/my student’s transcript to my school or district at the end of the courses and agree to all information under Sections A, B, and C.
