ESHA Food Processor Nutrition Analysis Software Usage **Terms and Conditions**

What is it?

The Department of Nutrition has access to the Cloud Hosted ESHA Food Processor Nutrition Analysis Software that is a powerful tool for analysis of dietary intake, nutrients and exercise. This software can be utilized to analyze menus, diets, foods, and recipes for research and academic purposes. Faculty, staff and both undergraduate and graduate students in the Department of Nutrition have access to utilize this software program.

How do I access the software?

Prior to use of the ESHA Food Processor Nutrition Analysis Software, you must sign up for and book time(s) of use using our <u>Bookings page</u>. You may sign up for 2-hour increments of use and can sign up for multiple 2-hour blocks of use by filling out the Bookings request multiple times. You will be emailed login information for the ESHA software cloud platform with your booking confirmation email. Please look for the login information within that email.

Requirements:

- Use of the ESHA Food Processor software is available on a first-come, first-served basis and is to be used for academic purposes only.
- You must agree to the terms and conditions outlined throughout this document upon your sign up for use of the software.
- When entering diet or menu data into the ESHA Food Processor software, all data must be saved under your last and first name using the following format: last name, first name.
- You are welcome to add additional identifying information to your files after your last and first name (e.g. last name, first name, date).
- Please remember to log out after you are finished using the software or when your reserved time of use has expired, whichever comes first.
- It is your responsibility to ensure your computer meets the <u>system requirements</u> for use of the ESHA Food Processor software.
- It is your responsibility to learn how to utilize the ESHA Food Processor Software. The <u>ESHA</u> <u>Cloud Support website</u> provides manuals and supports for use.
- Failure to adhere to any portion of these terms and conditions may result in denial of future use of the ESHA Food Processor software.
