Email a Professor

- Do **NOT** begin an email with Mr. Mrs., Miss, Dude, Hey or Hi there.
- Always start your email with a polite "Dear" or "Hello" followed by your professors' title/name – for example Dr. Liu or Professor Liu.
- If you are not sure what their proper title is, use "**professor**" followed by their last name.
- If you are uncertain, it is better to compliment a person than it is to insult someone accidentally.
- Nicety sentence - such as I hope you are enjoying the beautiful weather today.
- I am in your *Class Name*, that meets on *This Day* at *This Time*. This is the question I have.
- Use a formal closing. Use "Best regards", or "Thank you" followed by your name.
