These are sample questions that agencies may use when interviewing students.

- 1. What led you to choose social work as a profession?
- 2. What level are you? BSSW, MSW Foundation or Concentration?
- 3. Why are you interested in this agency/program? What do you hope to learn here?
- 4. What strengths do you bring to this field?
- 5. How has your academic coursework prepared you for this internship?
- 6. What previous work experience do you have and how can it help you here?
- 7. What qualities do you look for in a supervisor/field instructor? What would you need from me in order to have a successful year?
- 8. Can you give me an example of a time you worked well as a part of a team?
- 9. How do you handle conflict?
- 10. How do you manage multiple obligations (school, work, internship, family, etc.) and what do you do for self-care?
- 11. Do you have any personal experience with the issues we address at this agency that may impact your interaction with clients (domestic violence, child abuse, alcoholism, adoption, grief and loss, etc.)?
- 12. What is your availability?
- 13. What questions do you have for me?
