2024-25 CASFA changes that are the **SAME** as the 2024-25 FAFSA:

- Provisional Independent Student Status
 - Students with Unusual Circumstances
- Student Aid Index
- Siblings in college no longer a factor in SAI
- Up to 20 colleges can be selected
- *Dependent students are still under age 24

2024-25 FAFSA changes that **DO NOT** apply to CASFA:

- Direct Data Exchange (DDX) bringing over Federal Tax Information (FTI) on FAFSA, not CASFA
 - CASFA will still be doing manual income information entry
- "Parents" vs. "contributors" language
 - Student Spouse and Parent Spouse information required
- No activity on FAFSA will delete draft in 45 days/CASFA Parent invitation email will expire in 72 hours
- CASFA students leave SSN/ITIN blank if they do not have one, parents use 00000000

CASFA Legislation HB19-1196

- Public Institutions of Higher Education in can award the Colorado Student Grant to students who submit a CASFA demonstrating financial need
- Prior, the Colorado General Assembly funds had only been used to award the Colorado Student Grant to students who submit a FAFSA demonstrating financial need



CASFA Eligibility

Colorado Application for State Financial Aid (CASFA) is the state financial aid application for undocumented, Colorado ASSET students.

- ✓ I am not a U.S. citizen
 - o I qualify as a Colorado ASSET student because:
 - I have attended a Colorado high school for at least one year immediately before graduation or completed a high school equivalency examination in Colorado
 - I have continuous and physical presence in Colorado for 12 months before the start of the semester
 - o I should complete a CASFA if I have financial need, regardless of my Colorado ASSET eligibility
 - Includes students with DACA and TPS

The 2024-25 CASFA is open! Students can complete the 2023-24 CASFA for academic semesters in 2024.

The Colorado Application for State Financial Aid (CASFA) is the State Financial Aid application for undocumented, Colorado ASSET students. The CASFA bridges equity gaps and creates access to postsecondary education for Colorado ASSET students.

Qualifying for ASSET (Advancing Students for a Stronger Economy Tomorrow):


The General Assembly passed HB22-1155 [2], in-state tuition classification for Colorado high school graduates.

The law requires an institution to classify a student as ASSET for tuition purposes if the student:

- Graduated from a Colorado high school or was physically present in Colorado for at least one year immediately
 preceding the date the student successfully completed a high school equivalency examination in Colorado; and
- Has been physically present in Colorado for at least 12 consecutive months prior to enrolling in an institution.
- There is no longer a requirement for the student to be admitted to college within 12 months of graduation.

Students who do not have lawful immigration status and who do not meet the ASSET qualifications are still encouraged to apply for institutional aid using the CASFA. Students who are eligible for Federal Title IV aid by completing the FAFSA should not complete the CASFA.

Registration Eligibility



Colorado State Financial Aid applicants should only complete one financial aid application (FAFSA or CASFA) per award year.

To receive financial aid by filing a FAFSA, you must be either a United States Citizen or an "eligible noncitizen."

An eligible noncitizen is a

- 1. U.S. national (includes natives of American Samoa or Swains Island) or U.S. permanent resident (who has an I-151 or I-551 [Permanent Resident Card])
- 2. An individual who has an Arrival-Departure Record (I-94) from U.S. Citizen and Immigration Services (USCIS) showing one of the following status categories:
- Refugee
- Asylum Granted
- · Conditional Resident Alien
- Cuban-Haitian Entrant
- · Conditional Entrant (valid only if issues before April 1, 1980)
- Parolee (you must be paroled for at least one year, and you must be able to provide evidence from the UCSIC that you are in the United States
 for other than a temporary purpose with the intention of becoming a U.S. citizen or permanent resident)
- Modified parole requirements for
 - Ukrainian citizens and nationals paroled into the United States between Feb. 24, 2022 and Sept. 30, 2023
 - Afghan citizens and nationals paroled into the United States between July 31, 2021 and Sept. 30, 2023
- 3. Victim of human trafficking, T-visa holder
- 4. Qualify under Violence Against Women Act (VAWA)

- 3. Víctima de tráfico humano, titular de visa T
- 4. Califica con la Ley sobre Violencia contra la Mujer

Tips and tricks for 2024-25 CASFA

- When students edit their document to add or delete a college, the student is required to electronially sign (esign) again, while the parent is NOT required to esign again.
- Students and parents must esign the CASFA. There is no paper version.
- Students can SAVE their progress on their CASFA form using the "Exit" button.



Immigration Status-related Concerns

 The 2024-25 CASFA requires 2022 income tax information. If the student or parent does not have a Social Security number (SSN), they can apply for an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN). The ITIN application process and annual tax filing is separate from federal immigration enforcement and is generally safe (https://www.nilc.org/issues/taxes/itinfaq/) for undocumented immigrants.

Is it safe to use an ITIN?

Generally, yes. The IRS has strong privacy protections in place to ensure that immigrants who report their income and file their taxes are not at risk of having their information shared. Under Internal Revenue Code section 6103, the IRS is generally prohibited from disclosing taxpayer information, including to other federal agencies. However, certain exceptions apply. For example, the IRS is required to disclose taxpayer information to certain U.S. Treasury Department employees when they request it for tax administration purposes or to other federal agencies if it's needed for a nontax criminal investigation and a federal court has ordered that it be provided.

Immigration Status-related Concerns (cont)

- The CASFA currently uses the language "DACA number", which is merely a colloquial term because a formal "DACA number" doesn't exist. If a student has DACA, they can apply for an Employment Authorization Document (EAD), or work permit, and with their EAD then can apply for an SSN.
 - If a student has DACA, they enter their SSN into the CASFA.

Accuracy with names, date of birth, email address, etc.

- Students should use their full legal name to create their CASFA account and complete individual aid year forms/documents.
- Students should use extreme care to enter their personal information accurately the first time.
- Students without a Social Security number leave the field blank.

Creating an Account


- Students should use their personal email, not their high school or college email, to ensure they have continued access to their CASFA application throughout their post-secondary education. Students cannot make changes to their user profile once the account has been created.
- Account creation email validation messages may end up in SPAM folders. Please encourage students and families to check there.

Ensure applicant enters parent information accurately.

Parents without a SSN or ITIN enter 000000000

Menu along lefthand side of form/document can be used to determine which sections are complete and which need to be completed.

Skip logic technology generates information based on applicant responses.


