

The Academic Policies Committee (APC)

The committee views all undergraduate and graduate academic policy (most of which is located in the Catalog) for recommendation to the Senate and Provost.

The Budget Committee (Budget)

The committee informs the Senate on University-wide budgetary matters and reviews the Faculty Senate budget.

The Curriculum Committee (Curriculum)

The committee reviews all graduate and undergraduate curriculum (both new programs, certificates, courses, etc., and proposed University-level changes) for recommendation to the Senate and Provost.

The Faculty Diversity Committee (Diversity)

The committee informs and makes recommendations to the Senate concerning issues, policies, and practices related to the recruitment, hiring, retention, promotion, numbers, ratios, and diversity of the faculty, focusing on improving the numbers/ratios/welfare of under-represented groups within the faculty.

The Faculty Welfare Committee (Welfare)

The committee makes recommendations to the Senate (and other administrative bodies) regarding policies and practices concerning all faculty (full and part-time), such as benefits, faculty rights and responsibilities, etc.

The General Studies Curriculum Review Committee (General Studies)

The committee reviews all courses submitted for General Studies designation (new and renewing), as well as policies related to the General Studies program.

The Instructional Resources Committee (IRC)

The committee makes recommendations to the Senate concerning issues related to instructional resources, such as educational technology, CTLD, Access Center, etc.

The Ethnic Studies and Social Justice Curriculum Review Committee (ESSJ)

The committee reviews all courses submitted for ESSJ designation (new and renewing), as well as policies related to the ESSJ graduation requirement.

The Professional Leave Committee (Prof. Leave)

The committee evaluates all faculty requests for sabbatical and professional development leave.

The Reappointment, Tenure, and Promotion Committee (RTP)

The committee evaluates all promotion and reappointment dossiers that require Senate recommendations and reviews the PTR/RTP processes of the University.

The Rules Committee (Rules)

The committee appoints a Parliamentarian for the senate, considers procedural problems/disputes, reviews the constitution and bylaws, conducts and monitors elections and voting, and is the final authority for interpreting the Constitution, Bylaws, and Roberts Rules.

The Student Affairs Committee (Student Affairs)

The committee makes recommendations to the Senate concerning all issues related to student welfare (that is not academic policy) such as student/club activities, student government, etc.; and appoints a member to the Student Affairs Board and the SG: TSAC
