_____ I understand I must meet all other Title IV eligibility criteria in order to qualify for financial aid under the Fresh Start Initiative.

_____ I understand that once my financial aid disburses, my loans will be put into “in-school” status with my servicer. If I withdraw, graduate, or drop below half-time, my loans will go back into repayment. While in repayment on my student loans, I will be required to make payments and if not, my student loans may become delinquent and could go back into default status.

_____ I understand that not all loans received may qualify for the Fresh Start initiative and that the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships will determine if my defaulted loans qualify. If determined that some or all of my loans do not qualify for the Fresh Start Initiative, I will need to resolve those defaults before I regain financial aid eligibility.
