- Theatre Minors are encouraged to participate in at least one MSU Denver Theatre production each academic year (performance or technical). This can fulfill Practicum I or Practicum II. A Major is required in a different discipline. Please consult with your catalog year.
- Theatre Minors must pass all degree courses with a C- or better and maintain a 2.0 GPA average in all minor coursework to be eligible for graduation.
- All MSU Denver students must maintain a 2.0 GPA average overall. Please refer to your catalog for other university requirements.
- Theatre Minors should meet with a faculty advisor at least once every academic year to discuss course selection and sequencing to ensure a timely graduation. Students should consult departmental course rotation guide.
