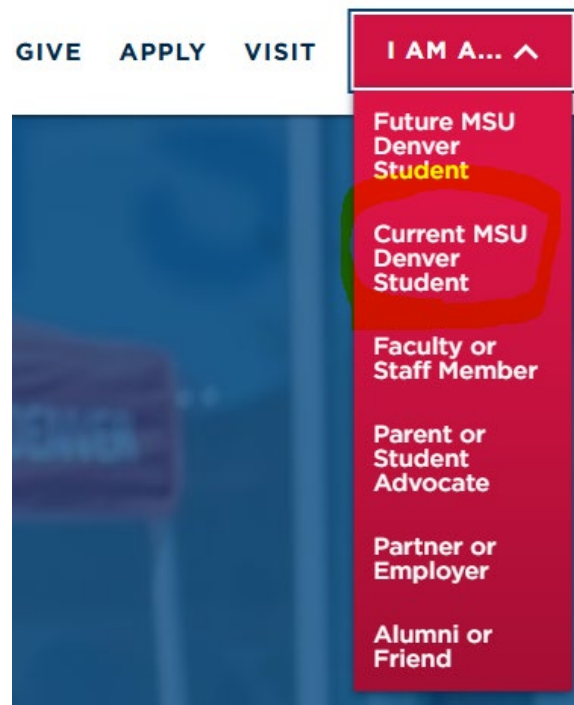


Verify Your Cost of Attendance Financial Aid

2. Select Current Student

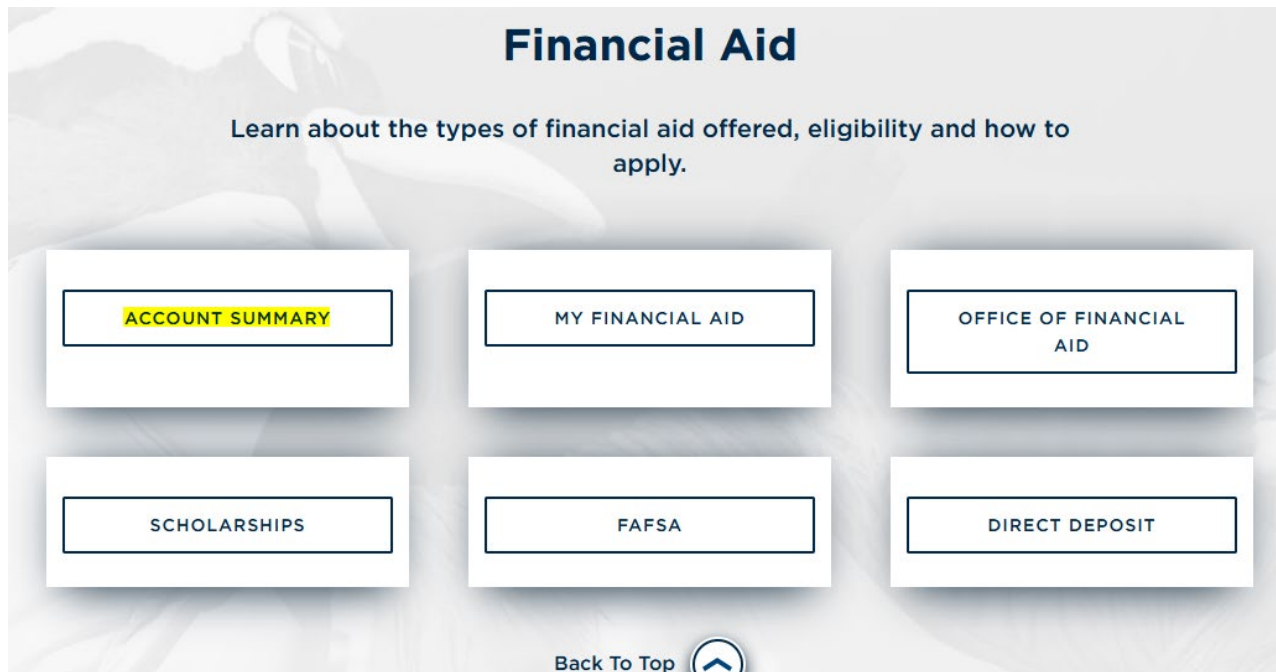


3. Select Financial Aid

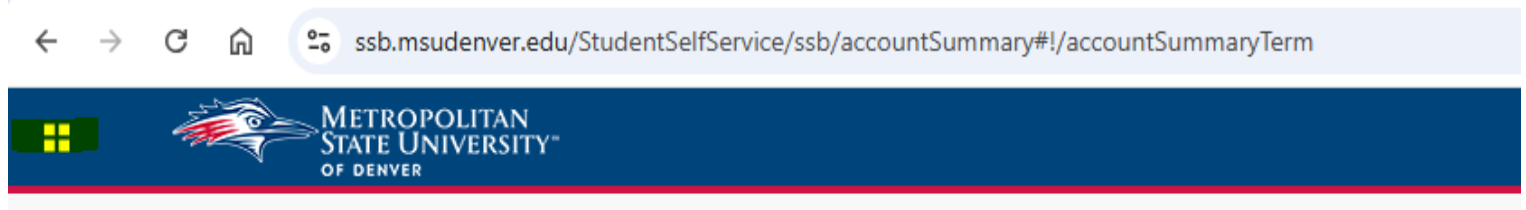

4. Select Account Summary

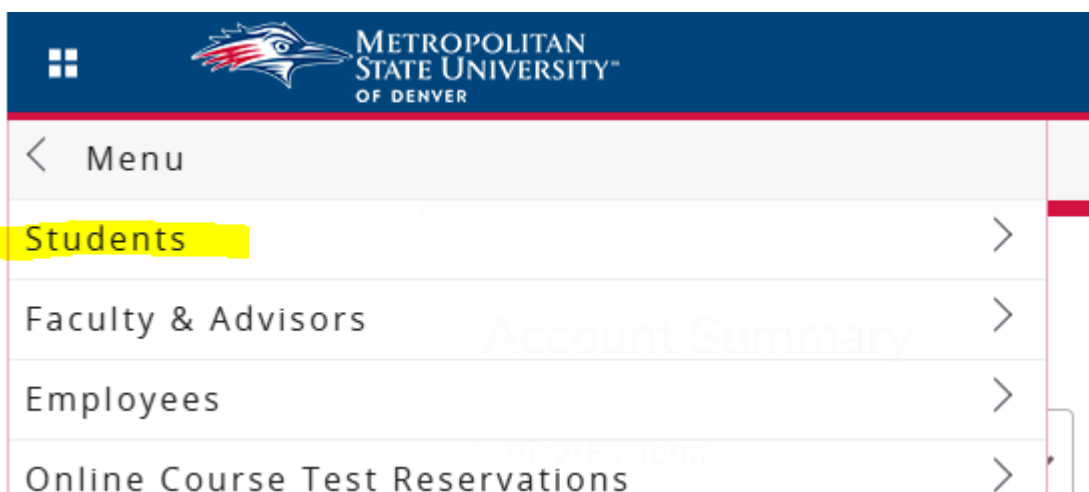


5. Click on the 4 squares on the upper left-hand side of the screen

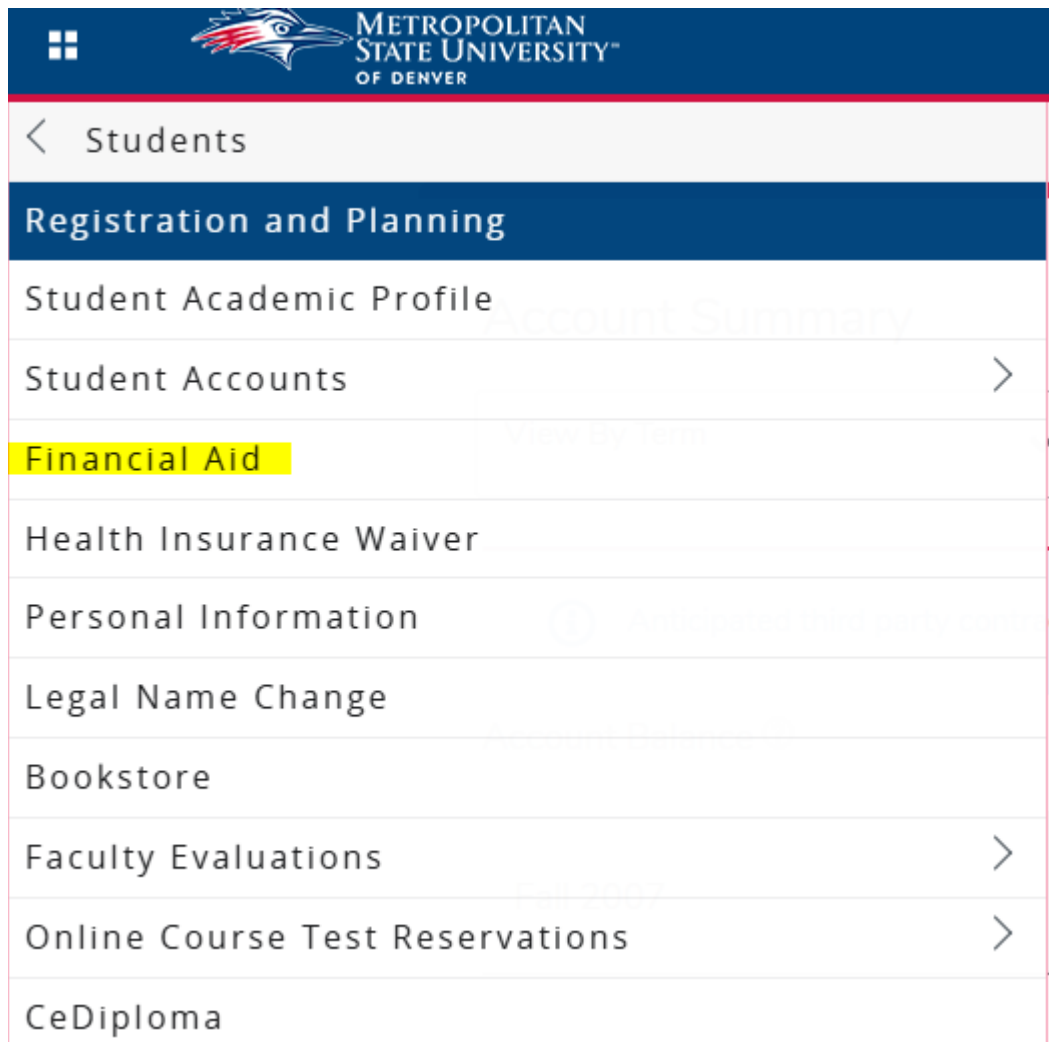


6. Select Menu

This will give a complete view of your financial aid package.

Look at these costs for possible cost of attendance increases:

- Books/Supplies
- Housing
- Food
- Health Insurance
- Transportation
- Personal Misc.

Other circumstances that can increase your cost of attendance are:

- Medical or Dental costs not covered by insurance
- Costs of equipment or supplies required for a specific class
- Disability related expenses not covered by other programs
- Dependent childcare expenses incurred during while attending classes
- Purchase of a computer or computer-related equipment or upgrades
- Actual tuition and/or course fees that are higher than the average –
Do you attend summer classes?

If your actual costs are higher than your estimated costs you can appeal for an increase in your Cost of Attendance.
