## **THEATRE MINOR NOTES:**

- Theatre Minors are encouraged to participate in at least one MSU Denver Theatre production each academic year (performance or technical). This can fulfill Practicum I, Practicum II, or Practicum III.
- Theatre Minors must pass all degree courses with a C- or better and maintain a 2.0 GPA average in all minor coursework to be eligible for graduation.
- All MSU Denver students must maintain a 2.0 GPA average overall.
