Roadrunner Interstate Tuition Program

What is RIT?

RIT is the Roadrunner Interstate Tuition Program, a program specific to MSU Denver. Through RIT, students in the Mid-Central states (IL, IN, IA, KS, MO, MI, MN, NE, OK, TX, or WI) may enroll in MSU Denver's college programs at a reduced tuition level: 1.5x of the institution's Colorado resident tuition. RIT tuition is considerably less than non-resident tuition. For the most current tuition information please go to **msudenver.edu/cost.**

RIT Eligibility

RIT is open to students who meet both MSU Denver admission and RIT program requirements. Qualified students must apply and be admitted to MSU Denver and apply for by completing the following application **before the census date of their first semester**. RIT partners include these states: IL, IN, IA, KS, MO, MI, MN, NE, OK, TX, or WI.

By applying for the RIT program, you are indicating that you are not a Colorado resident and may establish Colorado residency during your time of attendance at Metropolitan State University of Denver. If you plan on establishing your residency in Colorado and would like to petition for in-state benefits at Metropolitan State University of Denver during your time of attendance, you will need to wait until at least **one year** after establishing Colorado domicile to be eligible.
