This interdisciplinary performance event is inspired by works and themes featured in CVA's *Dance of Resistance* exhibition. Students in the Interdisciplinary Performance course engage with the stunning artworks in the exhibition in this immersive, multidisciplinary performance event that they co-created as a collective. *Supernova* explores our human experiences of conformity and our fight for individual freedom, as we spiral towards the dream of becoming unapologetically ourselves.
