The **Three (3) Reads Protocol** is a strategy to help you understand mathematics word problems by reading the problem three times with a different focus each time.

The first time, to understand the story's or situation context.

The second, to identify the mathematical quantities and relationships;

And third, to devise a plan to solve the problem.
